## Welcome to the Institute of Public Administration Training & Education Centre



The Institute of Public Administration is the Irish national centre for development of best practice in public administration and public management. Our training and education programmes are tailored to the needs of public servants. Our research and publishing services offer an informed voice and forum for discussion and debate on public service issues.

The Institute of Public Administration's Training and Education Centre was completed in early 2000 and is situated beside Lansdowne Road Dart Station, in close proximity to Ballsbridge, Dublin 2.

### Facilities Include

- 150 Seat Auditorium  
(or two 65 Seat Lecture Rooms)
- 6 Lecture Rooms
- 3 Computer Rooms
- Business Centre
- Fully Equipped Canteen for  
Light Catering

Each room is fully equipped with the latest in room automation technology with a ceiling mounted projector and screen which can project computer / laptop, video and document camera. Room lighting and blinds are also controlled from the lectern via AMX technologies, allowing the lecturer / trainer full control of their environment.

### Barrington O'Reilly Auditorium

The 150 seat auditorium - which can divide into two separate lecture rooms - can be configured to meet all our clients needs. The auditorium is fully air conditioned.

### Training / Lecture Rooms

Our 6 training / lecture rooms utilise a networked PC built-in to a podium. All rooms can be configured to accommodate a range of different uses, ie. classroom, lecture, meetings or group discussion. All rooms are fitted with air handling systems for your comfort.

### Computer Rooms

The three computer rooms house 42 PCs. Each room can accommodate 12, 12 and 18 respectively with an option to combine two rooms to seat 24 students. Each room is equipped with Compaq PCs utilising Pentium 4 accompanied by 17" flat LCD monitors and can be configured to host any operating system or software by utilising Symantec Ghost. This versatility gives us the ability to accommodate all our clients. All computer rooms are fully air-conditioned.

### Accessibility

All our facilities are equipped to cater for people with disabilities, including wheelchair access and deaf loop system while incorporating adaptive technology. Limited parking is also available. Please give prior notice.

### Business Centre

Our business centre can facilitate up to 8 people with a range of services including internet access, access to our library's extensive electronic catalogue and printing / copying facilities.

### Wireless Technology

The institute offers wireless network technologies throughout the building. This network extends to our exquisite landscaped gardens, allowing our clients the freedom to roam and surf while availing of all our network services.

Video conferencing amenities are also available.
