Right Mindset - to challenge own thinking, perspectives, worldview.

Appropriate Skillset - to enable collaboration and innovation across the organisation.

Supportive Toolkit - to develop capacity to collaborate and be innovative about services, processes and people engagement.

This is why our new series "***Innovation and Collaboration for Growth***" offers participants, over a number of seminars, an opportunity to focus on:

- ✓ Building a more open and collaborative mindset;
- ✓ Identifying requisite skills to create zones of innovation in their organisation;
- ✓ Expanding the use of tools to lead processes of effective problem solving.

The seminar format will vary according to the topic. We will integrate case examples, visiting speakers and input from participants to complement the IPA experience in this area as a way to stimulate fresh thinking and build a cohort of effective practice in the Irish Public Sector.
