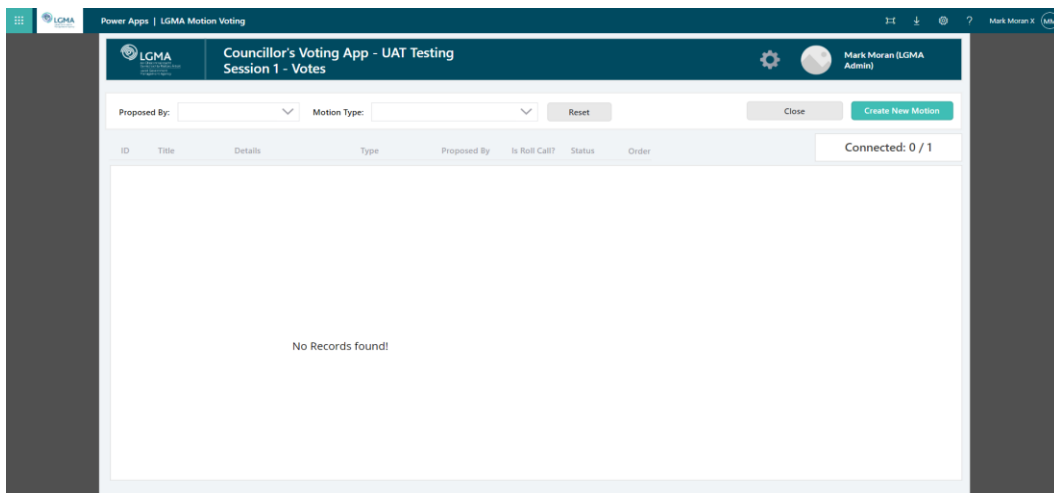
Current Status

- Testing planned with 3 Local Authorities and LGMA yesterday in LGMA 365 environment
- Next steps to install in each Local Authority (Fingal, Kildare, Cork County Council)
- Evaluation post pilot testing
- Per app licencing used €3.71 per user per month (if already using a number of power apps, a per user licence (€14.84 per user per month) might be more value). Buy off Dynamics Agreement if using per user.

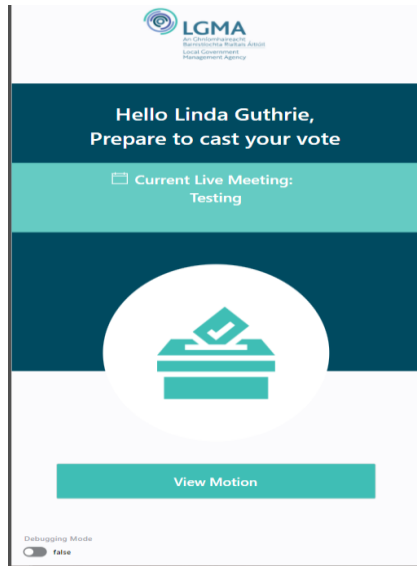

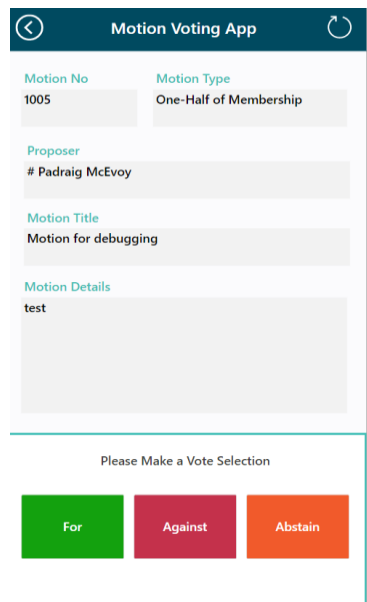
