The Irish Department of Finance 1959-99

Author: Ciarán Casey

By the late 1950s Ireland had suffered three economic crises in as many decades, falling significantly behind the living standards of neighbouring countries. Yet at the turn of the millennium it had reached virtual parity. This was all the more remarkable given the economic turbulence of the 1970s and the deep recession which lasted most of the 1980s.

A major contributing factor to this historic convergence was a series of new economic and social policies pursued from the 1950s. While the cumulative effect of these was not anticipated, they produced a boom in the 1990s that was genuinely exceptional by world standards.

The Department of Finance had primary responsibility for setting economic policy throughout the period. It was also charged with a swathe of other responsibilities in its role as 'the Central Department'. Its Ministers and officials were key agents of the changes that transformed modern Ireland.

This book is based on unique access to the vast departmental archive, and gives deep new insights into the governance of the Irish state in these four pivotal decades in its history.

Good housing policy is good social policy. Indeed, what is little appreciated is that good housing policy is good transport policy, good health policy, good fiscal policy, good planning policy, good gender policy, and so on. The list is almost endless. Perhaps unsurprisingly, given how much money is spent on housing from multiple perspectives, a lot of discussion and analysis of housing – from policy to delivery – revolves not around issues of regulation, transport, gender, health and so on, but around the various internal subsectors of housing (private rental, social and private housing) and their respective markets. Issues in housing policy and outcomes are often couched in the economic narratives of price, value, costs, yields and opportunities. Indeed, due to the impact of (sometimes surprisingly ill-informed) discussion of the economics of development and the emphasis on market impacts, much analysis of housing provision sees construction as the beginning of the housing process rather than something that should be the outcome of analysis of its relationship with other, related issues. In other words, the physical manifestation of housing should be the culmination of other processes and not the start.

The Irish Department of Finance 1922-58

Author: Ronan Fanning

Since the foundation of the state, the Department of Finance has played a central role in Irish public affairs. For this reason its history is of major significance to all those interested in the evolution of Irish government and the Irish economy.

This book provides a description, based on the source documents, of how the policies of the state were evolved. For seven years the author had unrestricted access to the working files of the Department of Finance for the period – consulting the primary sources for the government and administration of modern Ireland.

The book describes, in particular, how the public service was established in 1922; the men who ran the new department and their policies; the traumatic impact of the first Fianna Fáil government in 1932 and the economic war which followed; the changes brought about by World War II and its aftermath. A major theme of the post-war period is the increasing politicisation of social and economic issues which brought the department more and more into the public eye; it provides, for instance, a detailed account of the origins of Economic Development, published in 1958. An epilogue outlines the major developments with which the department has since been concerned.
